Dear Parents/Guardians,

This clarification comes in response to recent queries regarding use of our school playgrounds during after school hours. The South Brunswick Community Education program uses our playgrounds on a regular basis until 6:00PM. We would like to be able to share this space with all and be respectful of parents who supervise their own children at play. In order to ensure the safety of our children, we ask that our families adhere to the following guidelines:

- Please closely supervise your children at all times, especially when using the playground equipment. Also, remind your children to adhere to the same playground safety rules applicable during the school day.
- Do not enter the building at any time to use the bathrooms, water fountains, etc. Community Education staff must monitor the entrances to the building at all times, and having additional children and adults in the building creates a potentially unsafe situation.
- Parents of students in the after school program are paying for a program which may include games, walks, or other special outdoor activities. These activities are reserved for after school students only.

Unsupervised children, or families not following the above guidelines, may be asked to leave, and are welcome to return after 6:00 PM. If you have any questions, please contact your school's principal or the Community Education office. Thank you for your anticipated cooperation as we strive to keep our outdoor facilities safe and enjoyable for all.
